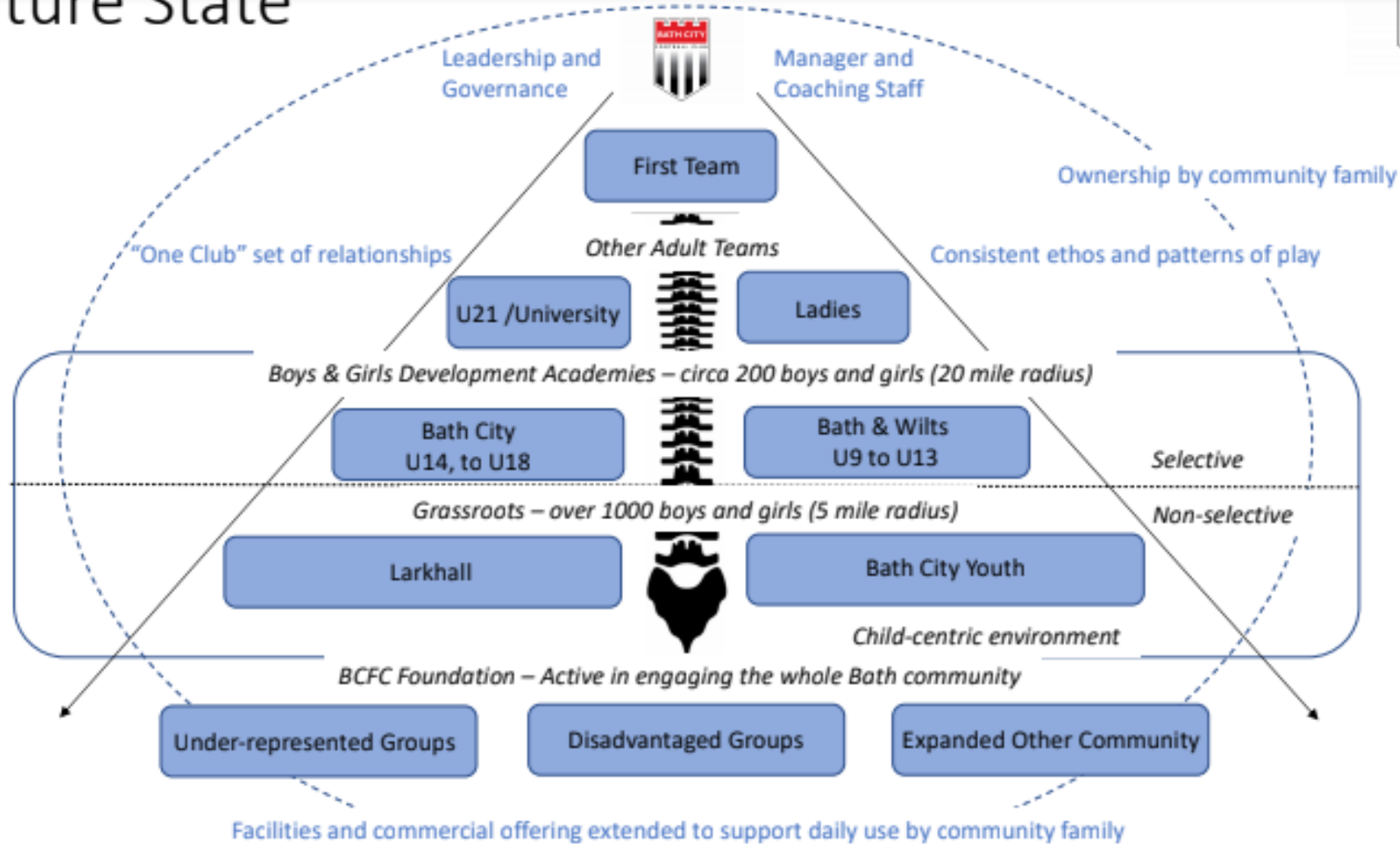
# Football Structure - Current
