Key Tasks	 Act as the first point of contact for those looking to support the club through volunteering Promote volunteering opportunities and proactively recruit new volunteers Liaise regularly with the club's working group coordinators to identify needs and match volunteers with the right opportunities Maintain a centralised database of volunteers, including skills and expertise where possible Keep in regular contact with existing and prospective volunteers to ensure they are satisfied with volunteering arrangements (NB - The VPO is not responsible for coordinating the actual work of volunteers on a day-to-day basis)
